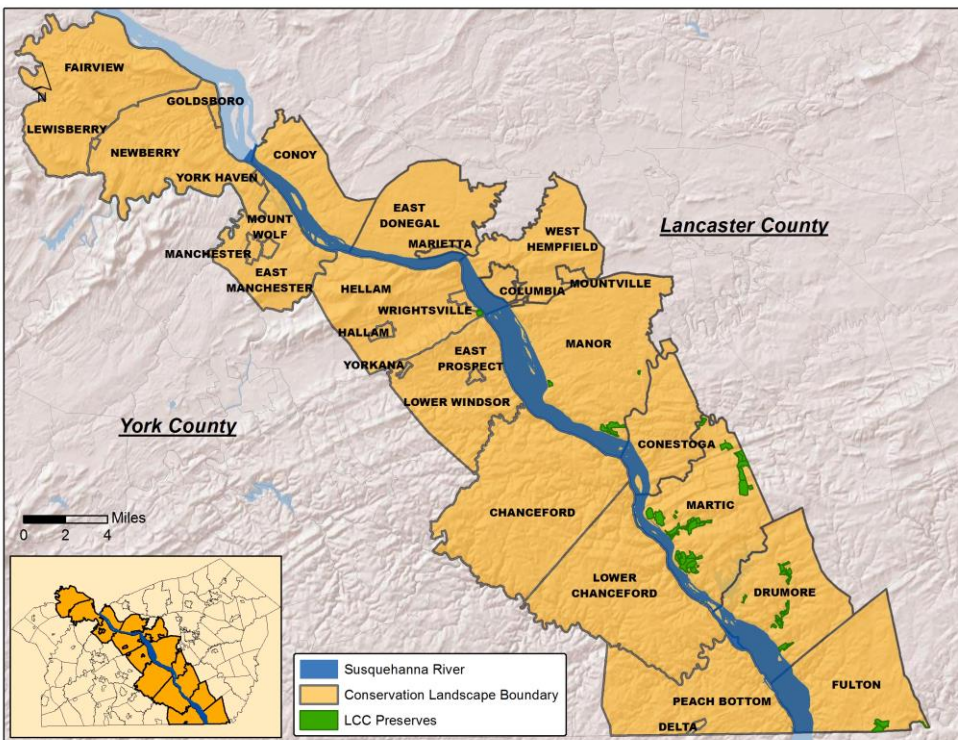


Susquehanna Riverlands Conservation Landscape Grant Program

The Lancaster County Conservancy is pleased to announce the 2017 round of the Susquehanna Riverlands Conservation Landscape mini-grant program. This program is a place-based strategy for the conservation, preservation, restoration, and recreational use of important natural lands and resources in the lower Susquehanna Valley.



With funding received from the Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources (PA DCNR), the Lancaster County Conservancy will be awarding grants that range in amounts from \$2,500 to \$25,000 for projects such as land conservation and preservation, stream and habitat restoration, passive recreation development, locally driven planning, and community economic revitalization efforts. Non-profit organizations with a tax-exempt status 501(c) (3), municipalities, municipal authorities, counties, and educational institutions are all eligible (non-profits must provide proof of non-profit status).

Mini-Grant projects should help to sustain the Susquehanna Riverlands sense of place whether it is through protection, promotion, or enhancement of our region's natural, historical, recreational and cultural assets. Projects that have the greatest benefit to multiple assets and have strong partner collaboration will be ranked the highest.

The Letter of Intent deadline is January 31, 2017 by 5:00pm. Projects funded through this round of grants must be completed by December 31st, 2018.
